# **Details**

# **Project**

The housing and infrastructure upgrades primarily focus on the repair and or replacement of health hardware for the purpose of ensuring houses in the homelands are safe and occupants have the ability to carry out healthy living practices (HLPs). The upgrades should focus firstly on safety and identifying urgent repairs and maintenance to housing and infrastructure. Secondly, the upgrades will improve the functionality of health hardware in houses in relation to whether it can support HLPs.

The priorities are:

# Improving healthy homes

- Safety
- · Healthy living practices.
- 1. washing people
- 2. washing clothes and bedding
- 3. remove waste safely
- 4. reduce overcrowding
- 5. improving nutrition
- 6. reduce the impact of animals, vermin or insects



- 7. reduce dust
- 8. controlling temperature
- 9. reduce trauma (potential accidents)

#### Improving local jobs and local decisions

The program will also contribute to the following outcomes:

- Community members have the opportunity and are encouraged to participate and contribute to local decision making within their community.
- Overall the quality of housing and infrastructure in the communities is improved.
- Employment and training opportunities for local residents.
- The use of local businesses to deliver goods and services through potential subcontracting arrangements is maximised.

House 12 is currently resided in by shower and 2 toilet residence, there are currently 3 adults and 3 children staying here and they were happy to move in with family for the duration of the upgrade works.

Marcela requested that if she could have the existing breezeway sitting area enclosed so that the family could access the toilet without going outside, fortunately, we were able to deliver this request and transform the house into something that they will be able to enjoy for many years, additionally we replaced the kitchen and installed new flooring to the kitchen and new lounge, bathrooms, toilet and laundry were all upgrade in the process. These items were a necessity in relation to providing the opportunity to embrace the Healthy Living Practices which is the main intent of this program.

We also had the opportunity to gift these houses with a new 500ltr fridge/freezer and an 8kg top loader washing machine.

The residents were very easy and accommodating to our request and have been a pleasure to work with over the last few months, and we look forward to working with them in the future.

# Landscaping

General Yard Clean including remove all rubbish

Repair and seal existing timber flooring (multiple small holes throughout)

Replace Entrance Sets and key alike

#### Install external screens (been removed)

Bedroom Windows 1800 x 1800

Bathroom Windows Service only 1150 x 850

Kitchen Windows 1200 x 900

Laundry Windows 1200 x 900

Toilet Windows Service only 900 x 640

Living Room windows (1800 x 1800)

#### General

Remove damaged CFC sheeting to floor and replace

Enclose breeze way to enable a secure area so that they don't have to leave the living area to use the toilet facilities  $(4000 \times 2700)$ 

Refix steps to entrance, install CFC sheet to step (1200 x 250)

Remove weathered timber flooring to breeze way and replace with CFC floor sheets (4000 x 7000)

#### **Electrical**

Replace external light with WP LED 1200mm

Replace external light in breezeway WP LED 600mm

Replace external light with new LED spot

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Upgrade to Distribution Board

Install mechanical protection to incoming water connections

Clean and service electric hot water system, provide a report.

Replace Solid core door, Privacy set, Vandal Plate & door stop

# EXISTING BED 4/Storeroom - 3000 x 4000 x 2700

#### General

Replace damaged FC sheet 6mm (1600 x 1200)

Service window sliders

Repair flooring to entrance of room

Install new SS wardrobe with Shelf 1200 x 1800

Dispose of BOX AC in window and replace (425 x 600) including new RAC frame

Replace Solid core door, Privacy set, Vandal Plate & door stop

Remove damaged substrate flooring and replace with 19mm CFC Dura flooring

#### **Electrical**

Replace DGPO

Replace Ceiling Fan and Controller

Replace lights with 1200 LED's

# **EXISTING KITCHEN**

Replace damaged FC sheet 6mm (2700 x 1200)

Remove worn plywood floor and replace with new CFC flooring.

Replace SS Kitchen 2 x Galley style bench with splash back. (3680 x 600) centre of sink @2100 & (2500 x 600)

Install SS Splash back to Stove (900 x 1500)

Install new SS Pantry (2100 x 960)

Replace Stove with 32amp lead

Replace Stove Isolator and 32amp outlet

Replace Ceiling Fan and Controller

Replace DGPO

Replace light with LED 1200 and switch

#### **Plumbing**

Install new SS mixer to sink

Replace drain and trap to new sink

Install weather seal RP4

# **EXISTING HALLWAY 5100 x 1600 x 2700**

#### General

Replace missing manhole cover (600 x 600)

Install flashings or corner mouldings to exposed external corners

Replace damaged FC sheet 6mm (2700 x 1200)

#### **Electrical**

Replace smoke detector

# **EXISTING BATHROOM 2200 x 3400**

#### General

Replace Solid core door, Entrance set, Vandal Plate & door stop

Service window sliders

Demolish existing tiles and bathroom fixtures

Replace lami panel 6mm (2400 x 1200)

Waterproof wet area

Install new hob for shower recess

Retile wet area with new tiling

Install new shaving cabinet

Allowance to repair water damaged framing if exposed (4lm)

Install new towel rack/roll holder

Install new SS mirror

Remove damaged substrate flooring and replace with 19mm CFC Dura flooring

#### **Electrical**

Replace LED 1200 WP and Switch

# **Plumbing**

Install new tapware, and shower head

Replace existing tapware with SS mixer

Replace drain and trap to new sink

Demolish existing bath tapware and install new shower breach if required

Install new floor waste

Jet blockage in drain from IO to septic tank

Replace Solid core door, Entrance set, Vandal Plate & door stop

Demolish existing tiles and toilet fixtures

Replace lami panel 6mm (2400 x 1200)

Waterproof wet area

Retile wet area with new tiling

Service window sliders

Replace LED 600 WP and Switch

## **Plumbing**

Replace complete toilet and cistern

Replace hand basin - small

Replace drain and trap to new sink



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Replace toilet water outlet

# **EXISTING EXTERIOR LAUNDRY 2200 x 3400**

#### General

Demolish existing tiles and laundry fixtures

Replace SS bench and laundry trough

Waterproof wet area

Replace lami panel 6mm (2400 x 1200)

Retile wet area with new tiling

Service window sliders

Replace Solid core door, Entrance set, Vandal Plate & door stop

Remove damaged substrate flooring and replace with 19mm CFC Dura flooring

# **Electrical**

Replace DGPO WP

Replace LED 1200 WP and Switch

# **Plumbing**

Replace mixer to laundry sink

Replace washing machine tap outlets

Install new SS basin

Replace drain and trap to new sink
