Project Overview

This project was funded under the 2024–25 Homelands Capital Grant Program to replace and install:

- septic tank and reln drain for house 4 and public toilet block
- 25000L water tank to community

The project aimed to restore reliable water supply infrastructure and reinstate system redundancy essential for community water security.

Scope of Works Completed

- Supply and installation of one new 25,000L polyethylene water tank;
- Decommissioning and removal of the existing failed tank;
- Associated plumbing works and reconnection to the existing water reticulation system;
- Repair damaged drainage inlet and outlet of septic
- Provision of a Section 40 Certificate of Compliance (Plumbing and Drainage Design) for the completed works.

Compliance

All works were completed by a licensed NT plumbing contractor in accordance with:

- NT Building Act (Section 40) – Certificate of Compliance (Plumbing and Drainage Works)



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- Plumbing Code of Australia / AS NZS 3500.2
Quality assurance included on-site inspections, photographic documentation, and confirmation of watertightness.

Employment & Local Content

Sub-contractor: GT Plumbing Solutions Pty Ltd – local East Arnhem contractor.

Employment: 5 personnel engaged (inclusive of Yolngu trade assistants).

Local Content:

- Procurement and labour sourced within East Arnhem.
- LHAC provided in-kind plant and labour support (Manitou & Yolngu plant operator).
- Works undertaken in coordination with homeland representatives.

Outcome

The project successfully:

- Restored full water storage capacity and redundancy at Bukudal;
- Improved water reliability for residents and reduced risk of supply interruptions;
- Delivered works using local labour and contractors, strengthening regional capability;
- Ensured compliance with Northern Territory plumbing standards.

Community feedback confirmed satisfaction with the quality and functionality of the new tank installation.
